
Local Assessment Trends Dashboard

To look at an Assessment with several strands in one view use the Assessment Results Analysis Report. Use this report for any assessment with multiple strand data.


First click on the Leadership Reports and Dashboards Tile in the home screen



Then click on **Dashboards** and then select the Cohort Analysis – Local Assessment tile




Use the filters to select the information you wish to look at. For this example, lets use the **NFRA FALL**, that would mean you select **Grades 4, 5, 6, 7** in the filter, then the **NFRA Assessment**, The **NFRA FALL** sub assessment, and finally use the **OVERALL** Sub Assessment Items. Then click **view report**.




Now select the Local Assessment tab at the bottom of the screen.



You will see a row of filters that you can use to adjust the report, and then a chart of the current school year proficiencies and a trend chart. Below these charts will be a list of student names and data. If you click on the red column in the proficiency chart, the list of names will adjust to show only the students with an emerging proficiency, and the trend chart will adjust to just show the Emerging trend for the last few years. Click anywhere in the proficiency chart to reset the chart to show all values.



If you select the Advanced Analysis tab at the bottom of the screen, you will see a different set of charts that show the proficiency breakdown for subgroups of the population. Again you can click into the charts to see a list of students in the table at the bottom of the screen.



You could use the filters to go through each of the sub assessment items in this dashboard. The other dashboards are like this example.

This report works well with Assessments that have a Overall Sub Assessment Item to view and you wish to see subgroup proficiencies in one view, the real power of this report is also the list of students that are provided and that can be sorted by proficiency.
