

School District 73 DNA Pre 2021-2022 Report



Some schools may use the Pre (Fall) and Post (Spring) information to create or revise school goals. In order to support school and district planning, the district collects and collates baseline information provided on the District Numeracy Assessment for grades 3 and 6 in the Fall.

Grade 3 and 6 All Students (standard filters, DNA Pre-Overall Sub Assessment Item)




The standard filters report will provide details for the main subgroups. The all-student section shows 29% of students are proficient or extending for the DNA Pre - Overall strand.




The trend line for the nonfiction reading assessment Sub assessment Item Overall shows consistent results over the last five years. The drop in the Developing score for this school year reflects the number of students that did not write the assessment (the blue dot at 17%).


Grade Breakdown All Students (grade filter, DNA Pre-Overall Sub Assessment Item)



Aboriginal Students (Indigenous Filter, DNA Pre -Overall Sub Assessment Item)




Family of Schools (Report only available at District Level) (DNA Pre-Overall Sub Assessment Item)


Report Building in EDPlan Insight
