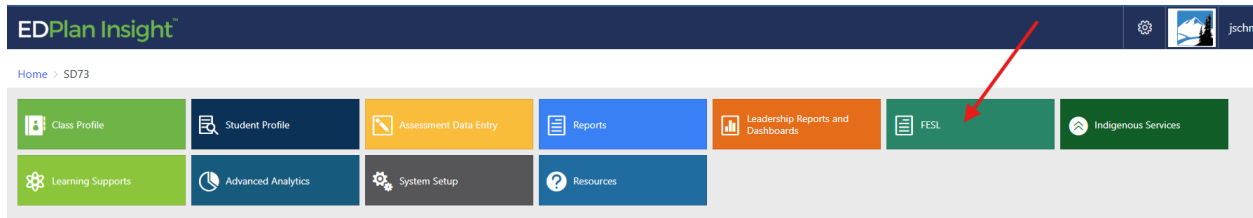
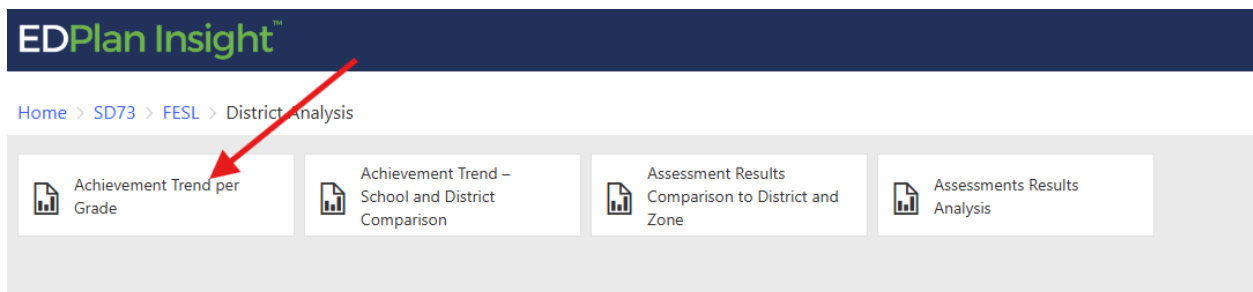


# Student Grade Assessment Report

This report, *Grade Data by Assessment*, displays performance trends over time for a specific grade level. It compares historical data for the same grade across different student cohorts, showing how achievement has changed year over year.



Then click on **District Analysis** and then select the **Achievement Trend per Grade** Report tile



Use the filters to select the grade you wish to look at. The report works for all grades within the same report. For this example, let's use the **Literacy (language arts proficiency)**. Select the **prior year** as there are no final marks yet select **all grades** in the filter, then **Literacy**, the sub assessment should be set to **RP-FIN** (Final Report card mark), Trend length can be **5 years** or your preference.

Then click **view report**
