

MyEducation BC Release Notes – Build 5.8

Release Date in Production: January 5-7, 2018

Release 5.8 introduces minor functional for ease of use in School and Staff Views.

The release also includes several OSC functional enhancements to address BC specific needs, and several corrections to functionality (with KBA references included).

Gradebook	The Categories side tab is back. It was removed in R5.6 and there has been consistent feedback requesting its return since then.
	Categories are now available in both in Course Section Details and in the Categories side tab.
Next Homeroom	Schools can now assign a Next Homeroom to students as this field is now editable by the Next School (i.e. receiving school) OSC-00272
Gradebook	Teacher created Course Nicknames now display in the Planner. OSC-00365 Staff View:
