Key Points

- <u>All TnT programs must have a start date that is the beginning of the school</u> year, and end date that is the end of the school year
 - Regardless of the start and end dates of the actual course(s)
- Graduated school aged students can no longer be claimed for funding. In a few specific cases we have graduated students completing a program past graduation, with external funding. Schedule them, we will remove funding claim at district level.
- Be cautious enrolling students in support block (XSPBK) as it will cap the student at 8 funded courses
 - 7 courses welding + 4 Youth Work + 4 regular courses = 15 courses, 8 with XSPBK
- Only use TnT program codes and courses for TnT programs



IDS = Independent Directed Studies

Follow the IDS Guide in the Zimlets

- Principals must approve every IDS course <u>before</u> submitted for funding on the 1701
- Every step in the guidebook must be followed for audit purposes
- Please forward a copy of IDS documentation to Kira Wood
