Functional Area	Details
Minor Release	 Exception error no longer displays when printing report cards with Publish tab enabled. The Publish report dates on parameter form are modified to use the format identified in a user's preferences. Users will now only be able to assign students from within their own district as members of a group. The student user account, created after a student has moved from another district, is now correctly attached to the district which created the account. Users will only be able to select staff from their own district when merging staff.
School Transcript	 Modified School Transcript to: Display the grade 10 -12 course if the grade entered on student transcript is not 10, 11 or 12. Display Expectation of Graduation message correctly. Display the elective and required categories correctly. Display 'Grade 12 School%' 'Exam %' only for Grade 12 courses. Display the IDS courses correctly, e.g. (MIDS course) if there is a related course entered for the course.
Diploma Verification Report	Modified Diploma Verification Report to display the earned credits correctly.
PSR	 Modified PSR to: Display the final mark correctly for Q code courses. Display the withdraw reason.
Diploma Information Report	Modified Diploma Information Report to display the projected Grad year.
Report Cards	 Modified Secondary Report card to display period attendance correctly. Modified Report card to print the course in a page. Previously the report card was printing a single course in two pages if the comments are long. Modified Report card to display all current year courses. Previously the report card was not displaying Grade 10 level courses for a grade 09 student.
GDE Extracts	Modified GDE Student Demographic extract to correct the exception error and delimiting problem. The name fields in the Student Demographic GDE extract now export with text qualifiers. Street Direction is displaying correctly on student demographic extract.
